

5 Different Ideas for **LOO**king at Art with Kids!

1. Ask your kids questions while looking at works of art, such as: What do you notice? What do you see in the artwork that makes you say that?
2. Look closely! Ask your kids to name the colors, describe the texture, or list the materials that the artist might have used.
3. Look at the Museum label and read the title of the art work. Does the title match what you think the work is about? What would you name it? Why?
4. Play "I Spy" with your students to identify different shapes, colors, and objects they might see in works of art.
5. Use your imagination and senses! Ask your kids what they would see, smell, or hear if they were inside a work of art.
