## 5 Different Ideas for Looking at Art with Kids!

- 1. Ask your kids questions while looking at works of art, such as: What do you notice? What do you see in the artwork that makes you say that?
- 2. Look closely! Ask your kids to name the colors, describe the texture, or list the materials that the artist might have used.
- 3. Look at the Museum label and read the title of the art work. Does the title match what you think the work is about? What would you name it? Why?
- 4. Play "I Spy" with your students to identify different shapes, colors, and objects they might see in works of art.
- 5. Use your imagination and senses! Ask your kids what they would see, smell, or hear if they were inside a work of art.
